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1 CLIENT BRIEF

To improve the customer restaurant by offering a solution that provided consistent cooling, in particular the warmer months, giving customers a more comfortable environment to enjoy.

Mercury were also asked to install a cooling solution to the on-site bakery to improve working conditions for the bakers.

2 OUR SOLUTION

Mercury proposed to install a new Mitsubishi VRF system into the customer restaurant allowing for controlled cooling to the area. The new install was wired to the existing BMS system allowing for control via local space temperature sensors.

The bakery department had a new DX coil installed to provide adequate cooling during working hours. The air handling unit was roof mounted and linked to a remote Mitsubishi DX condenser.

3 PROJECT RESULT
